3:15PM Victim Barbara D interviewed – was not willing to go on camera due to unsightly rash on her face. Full description revealed and documented on possible paranormal incident.

General: Objects hover over the city in formation, mysteriously appearing and disappearing. Radical flight maneuvers. Set up two cameras to videotape the sky as Richard filmed everything investigators were doing. His camera, began to act very strangely. We had to stop several times, at times to try to correct mechanical malfunctioning. Possible EMF fluctuations were responsible.

Richard was able to get the documenting camera to work. But interference was still affecting us. The second camera started acting bizarre, the chromatic seemed to be jumping. The third camera would not allow us to set it, and we later found out the sound got out of synch with picture.... The good news, Crayton filmed not, one, not two, but dozens of UFOs. So we had confirmation that UFOs were in the atmosphere and it was just a matter of catching them on tape.

Richard challenged Crayton that his UFOs were fast moving insects. Crayton became agitated – partially due to sweltering heat. Because airborne elements may have caused Barbara D's rash, Jennifer collected area samples for forensics analysis.

Event Occurrence ASI Headquarters same day

DATE/TIME: September 5, 2005 20:30 hrs. (Night)

Weather Conditions: Cool, partially cloudy.

LOCATION: UFO Headquarters/Classified
General Area :Sherman Oaks, Ca.

INVESTIGATORS: Brandon Scott, Sean Crayton Jennifer Patton, J.J. Barmettler and Richard Smith

ACTIVITY: Review the video tape of the day. Set up video viewing equipment and go through five hours of footage. Multiple stations. Evaluate footage shot.

ABSTRACT: ASI team members are shocked and pleased to have captured so many Unidentified Flying Objects. Under Crayton's supervision they catalogued the different types caught on tape. Crayton briefs ASI investigators on UFOs captured based on historical captures. Brandon states that some of the UFOs appear organic in nature.

CONCLUSION: There was definitely some extraordinary paranormal activity that was caught on tape. Footage and UFO objects under analysis and are considered unknowns. Brandon takes samples to show to experts. The team determines it is necessary to return to Topanga with specialists. It is undetermined if these objects had anything to do with Barbara D's facial rash. Forensics analysis shows heavy traces of Jet Fuel type "A". Location is under LAX flight path and could be responsible for facial rashes. Also high pollen counts in the area suggest allergy related rashes are possible in that area. Team discovered small UFO that "buzzed" Jennifer while taking samples in elevate cave to determine it is not an object that is recognizable, spiral shape, extraordinary high rate of speed, undetectable by the human eye. Video playback documented this object in four frames of video. J.J., who shot footage, recalls an abnormally bright flash of light at the moment captured on video. Jennifer was very uneasy with this phenomenon and witnessed in slow-mo on tape, multiple objects in front of her face that she was not aware of at the time. The object that buzzed her was also undetected by her and appeared to be "checking her out". Jennifer felt "creeped out" by the incident.

Event Occurrence Field Test

DATE/TIME: September 7-12 2005 Various

Weather Conditions: Various

LOCATION: Classified General Area :Studio City, Ca.

INVESTIGATORS: Brandon Scott, UFO experts, Analysis Experts (see below)

ABSTRACT: Brandon experiments with the one of the same cameras used in Topanga. Videotapes sky over San Fernando Valley. Although some debris and lens flairs were apparent, there were no UFO's caught on tape in this location. Brandon confers with experts.

ANALYSIS: Brandon shows Topanga Canyon video footage and photographs to 2 UFO experts (choosing to be anonymous) who cannot determine what the objects are. Brandon also shows footage to a bug expert who also has never seen this kind of photographic imagery and does not know what it could be. Brandon then contacts Dr. Hurtak and shows him the material. Dr. Hurtak shares with Brandon knowledge of these objects, and that they could be some sort of extraterrestrial probes. Inquires were made as to the threat these could present. Dr. Hurtak stated that from his research and experience no one that had been exposed to these were ever harmed or injured in any way.

Event Occurrence ASI H.Q. (temp)

DATE/TIME: September 15, 2005 Hour: 12:00 noon (daylight) to 20:00 (Night)

WEATHER CONDITIONS: Clear with Intermittent smoke from regional forest fires (fires in Simi Valley – approaching Topanga Canyon)

LOCATION: Classified General Area :Sherman Oaks Ca.

INVESTIGATORS: Brandon Scott, Danichi VamPyre, Sean Crayton, Jennifer Patton, Anastasia Davidov, Richard Smith, J.J. Barmettler,

ACTIVITY: Summary

ASI meets. Joining the team: ASI investigators, Danichi and Anastasia. We got together to review the material and come up with a plan of action to further investigate the sightings in Topanga. There was a full moon which affected Crayton and Danichi adversely. Prior to arrival Brandon encountered an auto accident (no injury) at the same time that Anastasia fell down the stairs at the meeting and slightly injured her hand. Fortunately Danichi is a trained medic and attended her injury. The energy was very strange all day.

Before starting our briefing, we went to Starbucks for a coffee run. Danichi left two of his men posted at temp H.Q. (I did not discover this till later). At Starbucks, Danichi spotted a man who seemed to be keeping an eye on us. Brandon witnessed him, he had a very intense look in his eyes, very well dressed, speaking on a cell phone, and appeared to be observing us. Danichi followed intelligence procedures and circled the block before we took off to assess his post standing. Anastasia declared that she felt she had just stepped into a James Bond movie. Back at the meeting, we sought to identify and evaluate the events currently occurring in the Topanga area. Danichi went into remote viewing mode and leaped to the map on the wall, he started naming coordinates.

Crayton correlated Danichi's alleged UFO sightings on National UFO Reporting Center and confirmed UFO sightings were occurring simultaneously with Remote Viewing. Details on remote viewing session is classified. The team reviews and analyzes the footage from the Sept 5th Expedition. Crayton briefs the team on the anomalies. Danichi shares his knowledge of the objects from his military experiences. ASI members evaluate footage from Field Trips and closely analyze the UFO that buzzed Jennifer and the UFOs caught on tape from expedition. We discuss the search for a UFO expert who can help with the Topanga and find Preston Dennett author of "UFOs Over Topanga Canyon". Date is set for next weekend to return to Topanga. Brandon leaves to purchase Dennett's book, "UFO over Topanga Canyon". While at the bookstore (Barnes and Noble) Brandon is approached by a customer who has noticed the book he was buying. They engage in conversations about aliens. Turns out the person had witnessed a UFO and was also there at that very same time looking for a reference book on UFOs. Brandon also purchases a UFO birthday card for Crayton at Hallmark. The cashier then engages Brandon on a conversation about alien abductees.

Event Occurrence Field Trip # 2 New York Film Festival

DATE/TIME: Sept. 23 , 2005 Hour: 8:00PM (Night)

Weather Conditions: Cloudy and cool.

LOCATION: Hotel M.

General Area: Sunset Blvd. Hollywood , Ca.

EQUIPMENT USED: Canon GL-1 DV camera, mics, camera mount light.

INVESTIGATORS: Brandon Scott, Sean Crayton, Richard Smith, J.J. Barmettler.

INTERVIEWED: Seven UFO investigators, leads.

ACTIVITY: The teams attends the New York Film Festival knowing to find people from inside the UFO community attending the premiere of Victoria Lundquist's UFO film "ENCOUNTERS with ANGELS, UFO's and DIVINE MESSAGES"

Brandon recognizes and interviews several UFO investigators and asks about Topanga. Sandra Marsh a MUFON officer confirms that she herself had witnessed many UFO ships hovering at low altitudes in the canyon. Present is a NASA scientist who provides his theory on the probes. All interviewed vouch for the credibility of Preston Dennett and his work. Also interviewed filmmakers of "Phoenix Lights" Documentary who agreed to work with ASI on future investigation for the Phoenix Lights phenomenon.

Event Occurrence Field Trip #3

DATE/TIME: September 24, 2005 Hour: 012:00 noon (daylight) to 20:00 (Night)

WEATHER CONDITIONS: Clear

LOCATION: Classified

General Area :Topanga Canyon (Mountain Region: numerous locations)

EQUIPMENT USED: 3 Consumer cameras from different angles.

Sony DCR900, Panasonic mini DV and Sony DSR DV Cam. Wireless mics, reflector, etc.

MATERIAL GATHERED : 4 one hour mini DV tapes of footage of the sky and activity.

Four DV Cam tapes. Documentation of ASI team in action was shot by J.J. Barmettler and videographer Richard Smith.

INVESTIGATORS : Brandon Scott, Danichi VamPyre, Sean Crayton, Jennifer Patton, Anastasia Davidov, Richard Smith, J.J. Barmettler, Tiger Kinnear, and guest UFO expert Preston Dennett, Author of “UFOs over Topanga Canyon”

ABSTRACT: 1:00 P.M. Tiger picks Brandon up at Food for Less.

2:00 PM: All team members meet at Starbucks at the foot of Topanga Canyon. Preston Dennett meets ASI and converses with the team. We surprise Crayton with a birthday cake and gifts. Danichi trains Tiger in Remote Viewing. Suspecting the activity in Topanga was strong, we head up into the heart of Topanga Canyon.

2:45PM: Dennett briefs ASI team on the history of UFOs in the area, case studies and police reports. We set up to towards the top of the mountain, a different location from our first trip.

3:00 –6:00 PM: ASI set up base camp off Entrada Road parking lot. A unmarked helicopter circled the base camp. Danichi warns ASI team of possible danger in the area. Dennett discusses his b.g. and has interviewed over 100 UFO eye witnesses in Topanga Canyon. Dennett guides the group to a position on the mountain. Danichi remains at base camp with personal video camera. ASI sets up video camera surveillance chain. Dennett encourages ASI to engage in a relaxation exercise to get us susceptible to a possible UFO encounter. At some point Brandon gets the spontaneous instinct to stand up and point his camera in a certain direction. A second camera documents Brandon's actions as they occurred. Simultaneously different team members had a variety of experiences. Almost all felt dizzy and heard an odd humming noise. Tiger heard ringing in her ears. Danichi down at the base camp became extremely nauseous and noticed his compass going around 360 as all animal sounds from dogs, crickets and birds stopped. He videotaped the compass spinning.

6:10 PM: ASI regroups at base camp. Danichi confirms via each team member that there was a joint group physiological experience – Fighter Flight syndrome. All confirm moments of nausea and heartburn at the same time as humming was encountered.

6:30: ASI wraps out: All members experience slight fear and exhaustion. Tiger felt very uneasy about the entire situation and wanted to leave.

7:00PM: getting dark. We all pack up to leave. Majority of team leaves to go home.

7:45PM: Danichi gets a sudden psychic flash and urgently leaves shouting something about a Porsche and people in trouble. He gets in his vehicle and leaves abruptly. Brandon also leaves the location but stops at the Will Greer Botanicum to watch a theatrical production, interrupted at the gates by a phone call from Danichi urging Brandon to meet him 4 miles down the canyon's windy road.

8:10PM: Brandon arrives to witness several police cars and fire trucks blocking off traffic. With press credentials and video camera, Brandon breaks through the barricade and joins Danichi at the site of a new Porsche flipped over on its side. The two young passengers standing unharmed by its side. Police officer interviews Danichi who tells him he saw the vehicle fly though the air and flip. Later on Danichi and Brandon reconvene and debrief in a parking lot at bottom of mountain and discuss the premonition Danichi encountered and acted up and the possible link between that and the events we just witnessed on the mountain. Observe that people they encountered had no idea that UFOs and probes were present.

Event Occurrence ASI H.Q. (temp)

DATE/TIME: September 25, 2005 9:00PM (Night)

WEATHER CONDITIONS: Clear

LOCATION: Classified

GENERAL AREA: Sherman Oaks, CA.

INVESTIGATORS: Brandon Scott, Danichi VamPyre, Sean Crayton, Jennifer Patton, Anastasia Davidov, Richard Smith, J.J. Barmettler.

ACTIVITY: Team goes over the days investigation and experiences. They review the tapes and discover that Brandon caught a significantly visible Unidentified Flying Object when he stood up from the group gathering. Crayton designates this UFO as a surveillance probe.

UFO DESCRIPTION: Fast moving oddly shaped, white, elongated, oval shaped UFOs.

ESTIMATED SIZE: : Estimated size of elongated UFO is 30 feet long. Estimated travel of fast moving object is between 2,000-3,000MPH. Need further analysis.

CONCLUSION: After analyzing both the Sept a 5th and this day footage the team assesses that Topanga Canyon is definitely a UFO hot spot. A consideration is made that the objects caught on tape could be related to possible UFO activity and speculated to potentially be either craft or probes. Could possibly be related to the Porsche incident Danichi encountered. Richard changes his opinion and has a paradigm shift in his belief system after seeing UFOs caught on tape. Further analysis and comparison to bugs flying indicate different behaviors and speeds. UFO caught by Brandon is remarkable and is under analysis. It was captured under typical protocols established by Crayton, only on a larger scale using the mountain range and setting sun to create the "halo" effect via JohnBro Technique.

Brandon, Joseph and Crayton spend hours viewing the footage frame by frame, cataloging and filing. Three different types of UFOs caught on tape. Compare time codes to affirm that UFOs on tape coincide with Investigators abnormal and joint physiological experiences and Danichi's odd compass spinning incident.

Event Occurrence Field Trip #4

DATE/TIME: Oct 1, 2005 Hour: 2:00PM (daylight to Midnight)

Weather Conditions: Smokey skies. Heavy fires in the area.

LOCATION: Topanga Canyon general population areas:

GENERAL AREA: Topanga Canyon (Mountain Region: numerous locations)

INVESTIGATORS: Brandon Scott, Richard Smith, J.J.Barmettler.

WITNESSES: Various

ABSTRACT: Brandon Scott conducts general "man on the street" interviews with individuals from the general population in Topanga Canyon. Videotape documentation conducted. Twelve residents were interviewed, neighbors, firemen,(at the station), store owners, locals, etc. Many had witnessed UFO activity. General consensus by the local population that UFOs are real and they are seen in Topanga Canyon area fairly often. The only individual who did not see UFOs in the area was the Captain at the Topanga Canyon fires station. These tapes are now logged and catalogued. Later on that night we met up with Julie L., a local connected to many area natives. We spent time in her home on top of a different mountain location in the area. She shared with us many stories. Her cat mysteriously got out and she was shaken with fear that that coyotes and wolves might attack the cat. We conducted a search and the cat

mysteriously appeared and was safe. Julie was more than relieved and appreciative. She agreed to take us to a remote location where UFOs have been sighted.

10:00PM: In pitch dark, using flashlights, we hiked to an even higher location inside the closed state park. Numerous Mountain Lion warnings were posted along the path. Camera's were set up to video tape the sky's. Due to the darkness images were not possible. We did not have infrared cameras in our possession, so it was limited to experiential. Other than planes and helicopters, no apparent UFO's were noticed or caught on tape. There were very strange, silent moving lights encountered but we deduced them to be a stealth jet or military aircraft.

Follow up Summary:

RECOMMENDATIONS: Continue ASI expeditions to the area. Interview residents with a longer history in the area. Bring new scientists, experts and infrared and thermal imaging equipment.

REFERENCE: There are various books on the history of UFOS in the Santa Monica Mountains and the Topanga region. **THIS CASE REMAINS UNRESOLVED.**
